Soldiers battle forest fire in Vientiane province

Soldiers in Vientiane province are battling a forest fire in Keo-oudom district, including the use of helicopters to deliver water. The fire is burning in woodland in Khamxang and Chengxang villages, and spread rapidly on April 25. The military command in Vientiane province mobilised more than 200 army personnel, village and district officials, district police, and local adults to fight the fire, supported by ground and air vehicles. The Air Force Command and the Combat Division of the General Staff Department have teamed up in the use of an ME 17 helicopter to survey the burning area and monitor the progress of the fire. The operation is based at two locations, namely in Chengxang village at the Nam Ngum 1 hydroelectric dam, and a strategic location in Khamxang village. Soldiers are conveying water to the burning area and creating a fire corridor to prevent the flames from spreading further.

Army personnel can transport 4,500 litres of water per trip, while local residents, village authorities and other individuals are also working to extinguish the fire. In Luang Prabang province, soldiers were also called on to bring a forest fire under control. Large swathes of woodland across the country are being burnt deliberately by farmers to clear land of vegetation in preparation for planting the rice crop. The Central Disaster Management Committee has instructed authorities across the country to pay close attention to the prevention and monitoring of forest fires, after fires have broken out in several provinces. The Committee advised local branches of the committee to carefully monitor their areas for fire outbreaks, especially in at-risk locations, and to prepare personnel, vehicles, equipment, a budget, and the materials needed to deal with a fire in a timely manner. Local authorities at all levels, together with local residents, are to be alerted to the risk of fires and must be prepared to respond promptly in the event of a fire. If a fire does occur, authorities in that locality are responsible for tackling

Economists, observers say China's robust rebound significant to global economy

BEIJING (Xinhua) -- Economists and observers have said that China's robust economic rebound will bring benefits to other economies, highlighting its role in adding impetus to the sluggish global economy. Kelvin Chisanga, a Zambian social economist, told Xinhua in a recent interview that the good start of the Chinese economy this year heralds great prospects for the economies of other countries in the world. Chisanga said the recovery is a sign that China is slowly overcoming the adverse effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, commending China's resilience in tackling the challenges. Data released by the National Bureau of Statistics last week showed that China's GDP grew 4.5 percent year on year in the first quarter, beating the consensus forecast and

Australia supports education for non-Lao speaking children

Education authorities have approved the revised Spoken Lao Programme materials to support non-Lao speaking Grade 1 students in remote primary schools. The revised materials will be used for an extended pilot project in 21 districts of 10 provinces this year. The Ministry of Education and Sports, with support from Australia, last week held a meeting to approve the Spoken Lao Programme teaching and learning materials. Speaking at the meeting, Director General of the ministry's Research Institute for Educational Sciences, Dr Onkeo Noumannavong, said the pilot project will start in September. Grade 1 students

languages, according to the BEQUAL programme. The mother tongue of almost 40 percent of Lao people is a language other than Lao. Most children in remote and disadvantaged areas are likely to start their first year of school without knowing Lao, which is the language of instruction in all schools. If students aren't competent in the language of instruction, it is extremely challenging for them to understand the teacher, participate in activities, and achieve the expected learning outcomes. In 2019, BEQUAL launched the Spoken Lao Pilot to test a new approach for supporting students who are not competent speakers of Lao. The materials were piloted in four provinces during Phase 1 of the BEQUAL programme, ending in June 2021. The evaluation found that the Spoken Lao pilot scheme was particularly effective in Phongsavang province. In addition, the Lao government, with the support of the Australian government, looks at additional ways to provide learning opportunities for all teachers about teaching students who do not speak Lao as their first language. A Teacher Development Video explaining five basic techniques for supporting students from non-Lao speaking backgrounds was released in October 2022. The techniques are simple and can be easily applied in the classroom to ensure that all children have equal opportunities to participate in learning.

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Did you know that the mother tongue of almost 40% of Lao people is a language other than Lao? With Lao being the language of instruction in primary schools, many students from remote and disadvantaged areas are likely to start their first year of school without understanding their teacher.

To answer this challenge, the Ministry of Education and Sports of Lao PDR, with support from Australia, launched the Spoken Lao Program in 2019 to test a new approach to support students who are not competent speakers of Lao.

Newly revised teaching and learning materials have just been approved by the team from the Lao Language Teaching for Ethnic Groups Research Division.

These materials will be used for an extended pilot in 21 districts across 10 provinces, starting in September 2023.

Laos approves revised Spoken Lao Programme materials to support non-Lao speaking students in remote schools

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KPL (KPL) The Lao PDR is a culturally rich and diverse country, with four main ethnolinguistic groups incorporating over 50 languages. The mother-tongue of almost 40% of Lao people is a language other than Lao.

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On 20-21 April, Dr. Oneko Nouannavong, Director General of the Research Institute for Educational Sciences (RIES) was the chairman of the "Meeting for the Approval of Spoken Lao Programme Teaching and Learning Materials". Many stakeholders such as Assoc. Prof. Dr. Bounlerd Sengsoulin, Faculty of Letters of National University of Laos, Assoc. Prof. Sengfa Holanouphard, Senior retired staff, Mr. Khambai Khamsy, Senior retired staffalong with the representative from Department of Teacher Education, General Education, Head of Divisions and staff from RIES attended the meeting.



Ms. Phonesiri Outhavanh, Head of Lao Language Teaching for Ethnic Groups Research Division, RIES, presented the revised materials. The Lao Language experts from the Approval Committee then made recommendations for the finalization and approval of the instructional materials.

In 2019, the Ministry of Education and Sports (MoES) and Australia through the Basic Education Quality and Access programme in Lao (BEQUAL) launched the Spoken Lao Pilot to test a new approach for supporting students who are not competent speakers of Lao. The materials were piloted in four provinces during Phase 1 of BEQUAL programme.



The pilot ended in June 2021 and was evaluated through baseline and endline testing of students in all control and treatment schools, as well as surveys with participating teachers and principals. The evaluation found that the Spoken Lao pilot was particularly effective in Phongsaly province. A case study with interviews and focus group discussions of principals, teachers and parents / caregivers was carried out in Phongsaly in February 2022 to understand better the reasons for this success. In addition, a teacher consultation workshop was held in Saravan in April 2022 to collect further qualitative feedback on the teaching and learning materials and to present proposed revisions for feedback. The curriculum writers from the Lao Language teaching for ethnic groups research division led by Ajan Phonesiri analyzed the results to improve the materials presented today at the Approval Meeting.



Ajan Phonesiri said "From the pilot, we understood better the amount and level of the content needed to suit Grade 1 students who are not native Lao speakers. Reflecting this learning, the content of the Spoken Lao programme was then adjusted for these new materials".

She added "Teachers and students were keen to have access to more Lao language teaching and learning resources, such as vocabulary cards, posters, games, and songs. We are planning for the development of those additional materials to ensure that children have as much access to fun and effective Lao language learning resources as possible."

"Teaching a new curriculum is always challenging for teachers, especially in the first year, and the challenge was increased by COVID-19 because it limited support and monitoring. Some teachers were still developing their confidence to deliver the Spoken Lao pilot. In the revised version, training and ongoing support will be expanded and will include face-to-face and online options. We also revised the teacher guide to ensure that it is clear and user-friendly for teachers based on teachers' feedback. We also developed guidelines for education administrators as well as community awareness communication on the programme."

Laos approves revised Spoken Lao Programme materials to support non-Lao speaking students in remote schools

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The revised Spoken Lao Programme will be piloted in treatment and control schools in 21 selected districts of Phongsaly, Luang Namtha, Bokeo, Huaphan, Xiang Khuang, Xaysomboun, Borikhamxay, Khammuan, Savannakhet and Saravan. The pilot will start in September 2023. Grade 1 students from non-Lao speaking backgrounds will receive three to four additional hours of instruction a week to improve their ability to speak Lao language. Improved speaking skills build a strong language foundation, which also helps improve these students' reading and writing skills. The participating teachers and district pedagogical support staff will receive the revised textbooks and teacher guides developed by RIES with support from BEQUAL, and training in how to teach spoken Lao lessons.

RIES with the support of Australia through BEQUAL looks at additional opportunities to provide learning opportunities for all teachers, on teaching students who do not speak Lao as their first language. A Teacher Development Video presenting 5 basic techniques for supporting those students from non-Lao speaking backgrounds was released last October 2022. The techniques are simple and can be easily applied in the classroom to ensure that all children have equal opportunities to participate in learning. And last month, the team from the Information Media Centre was in Phongsaly to film the next episode of the Role Model docuseries on a teacher who explains how she is teaching students who are speaking other languages than Lao and how she is collaborating with and supporting other teachers and liaising with the community and the parents.
